

October Raleigh Shag Club Meeting  
October 9, 2011

Stacy Marshall called the meeting to order at 6:10 p.m. at TJ's Nightlife.

Secretary's Report: Ann B. reported that the minutes of the August meeting had been posted on the website. Gordon Privette moved that they be accepted as posted. A second was made and the minutes were approved.

Communications Report: Debbie Brooks reported that she would not be returning as our webmaster for 2012. She said she has all the information needed and anyone with good computer skills could handle the job. If anyone is interested in this position, please let the board and/or nominating committee know. Ronn Knott was recognized for his great work on the past newsletters. He needs information for the newsletter by the declared deadline date. This date is to be enforced for submitting information.
